Subject: Inactive Membership: Duration and Review

Approval Date: January 22, 2013

Regulation:

In June and October all members who have been listed as an Inactive Member for a period of six months will be reviewed by the Branch Executive Committee (BEC), in order to determine whether he (1) should be re-designated an Active Member; (2) should continue to be designated "Inactive"; or (3) should have his membership in SIR terminated. The result of BEC review and recommendation will be communicated to the member by the Big SIR. The Member under review shall have an opportunity to respond to the recommendation before any final action by the BEC

The status of each Inactive Member, who is designated "Inactive" pursuant to this Regulation, shall be reviewed in accordance with this Regulation and Rules 90 and 92 every six months.

BEC History:

June 12, 2012:

MSP to limit to six months the length of time that a member will be listed as an Inactive Member, after which time the Inactive Member will be contacted to learn whether he wants to be re-designated an Active Member have his membership in SIR be terminated, or should continue to be designated Inactive.

MSP to approve Regulation.

January 22, 2013:

MSP to approve Regulation Revision 1.
